Activity Details	On this day, the school arranged for kindergarten K3 children to visit the Hong Kong Park Greenhouse, Aviary, and Victoria Peak. Through the visit to the Edward Youde Aviary, which simulates a rainforest environment, the children were able to observe and listen to birds in their natural habitat. Lastly, they took a cable car ride to tour the famous Hong Kong landmark, Victoria Peak. This not only connected them with Hong Kong's landmarks but also emphasized the importance of environmental conservation and allowed them to experience the joys of a spring outing in nature.

<p>During the morning visit to Hong Kong Park, with the guidance of tour guides, the children learned about plant species, cultivation methods, self-protection techniques, as well as the physical characteristics and habits of various bird species. This experience helped them understand the importance of nature conservation. While riding the Peak Tram, the children observed the cable car being pulled by steel cables and ascended from the foot of the mountain to the peak, enjoying the natural scenery along the way. At Victoria Peak's viewing platform and the Peak Tower, the children admired the view of Hong Kong below and the unique architecture of the Peak Tower.</p>				

	<p>Throughout the visit, the children showed excitement and anticipation. During the morning activities, most of the children were engaged in listening to the tour guides and actively participated in answering questions. They shared observations with the guides, such as birds eating different fruits like apples, pineapples, and dragon fruits, or how cacti store water in their bodies. While riding the Peak Tram and touring Victoria Peak, the children not only learned about the tram and the Peak Tower but also gained an understanding of Hong Kong's famous landmark, Victoria Peak. They admired the view of Victoria Harbour and enhanced their knowledge of Hong Kong's iconic buildings.</p>
<p>Suggestions for Improvement / Development Space</p>	<p>After the activity, it was observed that the students developed an interest in the famous landmarks and historical sites of Hong Kong. They continued to share their experiences of exploring Hong Kong in depth with their families even after returning to school. Teachers can further enhance this interest by adding related materials, tools, and cards to the free play area and library corner. Additionally, they can arrange for children to share their experiences of exploring Hong Kong in depth during morning discussions, fostering and maintaining the children's interest in Hong Kong's famous landmarks and strengthening their connection with the community.</p>
