Flag-raising ceremony

Activity Objectives

- Listen to and understand the national anthem.
- Understand the significance of the national flag.
- Learn the etiquette of flag-raising ceremonies.
- Enhance young children's national awareness and cultivate a sense of national identity.

Activity Overview

On national holidays, the Hong Kong Handover Anniversary, and other special occasions, all teachers in the school lead the young children in flag-raising ceremonies. Due to space constraints, Nursery (N) and Kindergarten 1 (K1) children watch the ceremony via live broadcast in their classrooms, while Kindergarten 2 (K2) to Kindergarten 3 (K3) children participate in person in the activity room. The children stand solemnly, sing the national anthem, and observe the flag-raising ceremony together. This is aimed at helping the children understand that they are Chinese, and to learn the significance of national holidays, the Hong Kong Handover Anniversary, and other special days.
